Dear Parents of Early Childhood, Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grade students:

On Monday, October 31, we will be celebrating Halloween by having our Annual Costume Parade and Halloween Room Parties. In order to ensure the safety of all our students, we will be using the following guidelines for our school celebration.

In choosing an appropriate costume for your child, please adhere to the following guidelines:

- No costumes depicting excessive violence (no fake blood, please)
- No weapons of any kind (squirt guns, chains, whips, plastic swords, etc.)
- Keep make-up to a minimum (there is only a short time given to students to get into costumes, so save the best for trick-or-treating)
- **NO ONE MAY WEAR MAKE-UP TO SCHOOL IN THE MORNING** (Early Childhood and Kindergarten students are the exceptions)
- Be certain that your child can see through his/her mask

Students in the AM session of Early Childhood and Kindergarten will parade at 9:30 a.m. Their party will start at 9:45 and end at 10:45 a.m.

Our Halloween parade will begin at 1:15 PM. and end at approximately 1:30 PM. All parade spectators are asked to remain outside for the duration of the parade. If you want to film the parade, please find a camera location along the sidewalk in the front or back of the building. All Halloween room parties will begin immediately following the parade and end by 2:30 p.m. Because our lunch time is so much earlier this year, we will not need parental assistance getting the kids in their costumes. Students will have a typical lunch/recess and get prepared for the parade once they return to their classrooms.

If you are volunteering in a classroom, please sign in on the sheet in the front hallway at 1:00. If you would like to take your child home with you when you are finished, please sign them out on the sheet provided in the classroom.

Due to various allergies present in our classrooms, we would once again ask you to please refrain from sending any treats to school for your child to pass out to his/her classmates. Our PTA's classroom representatives will have treats planned for students here at school. In preparation for the parties, classroom representatives are aware of any allergies and will ensure that whatever is provided for our students will be safe for all of them. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and we hope all our students have a fun and safe Halloween this year!
